

Legal and Privacy Guidelines

Privacy Information

PACTfoundation.org, a ucp, takes the issue of online privacy seriously. It is our policy not to collect email addresses of individuals contacting us for information. We compile statistics on our email traffic at the beginning of each month - at which time all emails from the previous month are deleted.

It is important for users of this site to understand that when emailing us for information, you will receive an email in response. For your own safety, it is important that you understand the ramifications of receiving an email from an organization such as ours, especially in the event that an unauthorized person should discover those emails. Additionally, you should be aware that when using email at your place of employment, your employer may have legal right to read and examine any and all communications made using their equipment and/or online accounts. While we regard all communication with us to be of a confidential nature, keep in mind that under certain circumstances, electronic communications stored in our system (OR YOURS, OR YOUR EMPLOYER'S!) can be subject to subpoena or other court orders.

PACTfoundation.org, a ucp, will not share or exchange information or emails with persons outside our organization. In the event that referral to outside persons or organizations is warranted, it is our policy to provide referral information to the requestor and allow them to contact the referral agency directly. In cases where we feel the need to confer with outside persons or organizations about a request received via email, we will contact those persons or organizations without forwarding the original email in order to protect the privacy and email address of the requestor since we would have no control over how securely it would be handled once it was received on the other end. We will then convey any appropriate response to the requestor.

Finally, be aware that email is NOT a secure form of communication. There is a long list of people who could have access to your email activity. Emails can be intercepted by hackers, printed, forwarded or inadvertently rerouted or read by others with access to your computer (partners, parents, children, employers, etc.).
