



Re: Please Support the Project Assist Citizens in Trouble (PACT) Foundation Reserved PACT Parking Spaces for Victims with Protective Order Initiative

Dear Senator:

As your constituent, I am writing this letter to urge you and your colleagues to act swiftly to fully establish the Project Assist Citizens in Trouble (PACT) Foundation Reserved PACT Parking Spaces for Victims with Protective Orders Initiative. The provisions of the Reserved PACT Parking Initiative must be implemented now so that vigilant bystanders can help protect victims with protective orders from the scourge of violent stalkers and domestic violence abusers:

I urge you to fully establish any necessary mandates for implementing Reserved PACT Parking. I am particularly concerned about the following:

1. To implement an effective and comprehensive national PACT decal public service announcement campaign.
2. To build awareness capacity in the local, state, and federal educational systems to promote safe and healthy relationships from pre-K through 12 grade.
3. To implement 4 PACT steps as a national standard for bystanders to safely intervene when witnessing a verbal or physical attack.

Citizens under the courts protection must have the option of choosing to have visibility increased for them that alerts bystanders to their being at a higher risk of potential attack. The 50 States and the Federal government must be afforded adequate resources to deter stalking and proactively help prevent domestic violence. A national victim protective order logo decal placard is a critical safeguard to help protect citizens under the courts protection from being victims of domestic violence. With each passing day that the provisions of the ordinance are not established, the danger to potential victims of abuse is heightened. When the general public is not educated and aware of proactive deterrents for stalking and domestic violence crimes, our communities are at grave risk.

I strongly urge you to act now to establish the Reserved PACT Parking Spaces for Victims with Protective Orders Initiative so that citizens under the courts protection have increased visibility and alert vigilant bystanders to help prevent abusive attacks from violent offenders and law enforcement is assisted in policing our communities.
